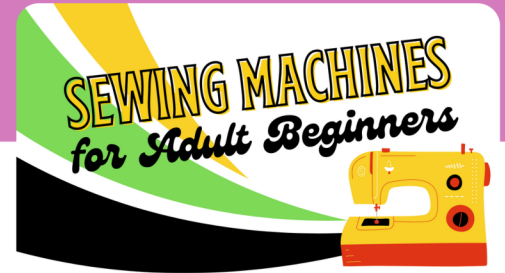
Monday, April 1 | 5:30 to 6:30 p.m.

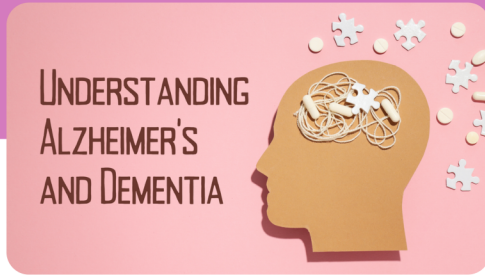

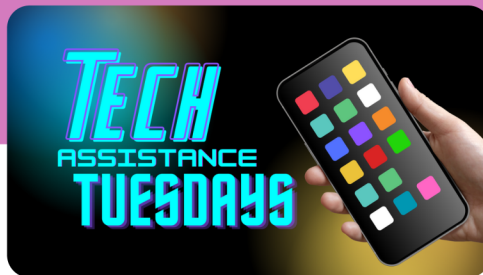

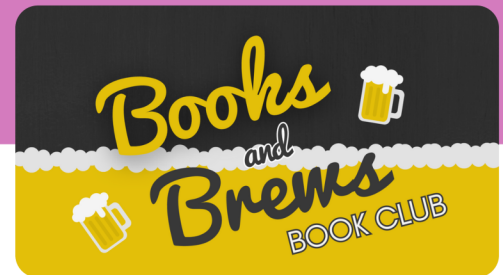
**Monday, May 13

Enter a state of calm while you craft your own candle. Free tickets are required and are given out 15 minutes before the program. Space and supplies are limited.



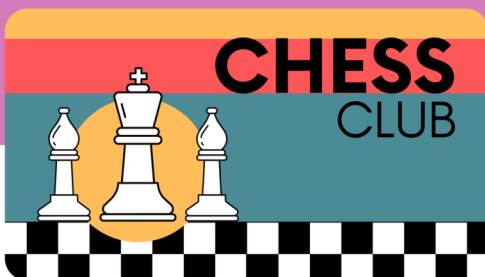
**Tuesdays in May, June, & July
