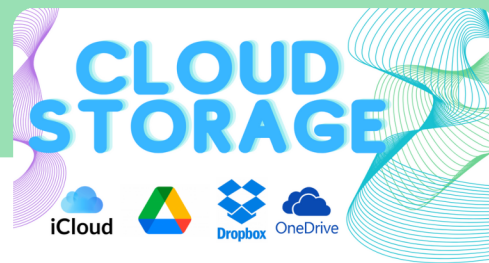
**Monday, March 31 | 6 to 7:30 p.m.**

In this demonstration for beginners, we will define cloud storage, explore its uses, and briefly discuss some of the cloud storage brands. First come, first served. Computers will not be provided.



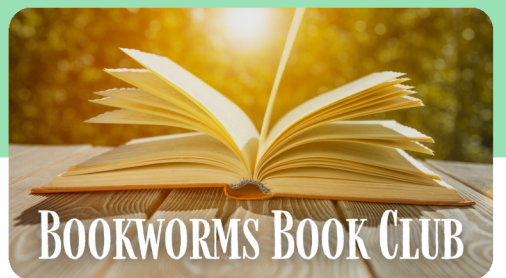
**Saturday, May 3 | 12 to 3 p.m.**
