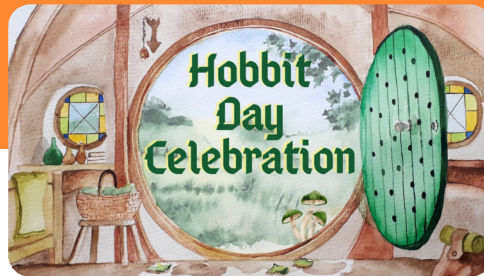
Wednesday, Sept. 17 | 6 to 7 p.m.

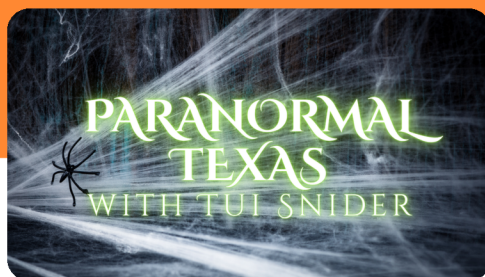
