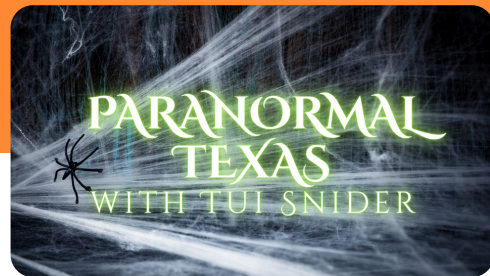

6 to 7:30 p.m.**

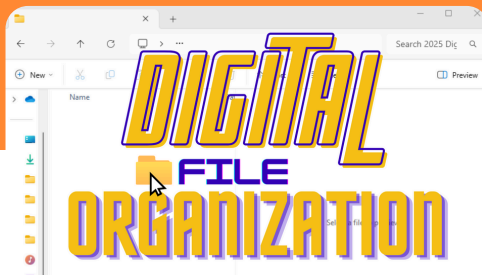
Whether you're sweating over debt management or retirement, this interactive class is a great first flex toward training in money matters. The first 25 attendees will receive a workbook to take home.
