TEEN ART SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

- We are accepting submissions of paintings, drawings, photography, and digital art from teens in grades 7-12.
- Entries will be accepted during business hours on November 1 23, 2025.
- All artwork must be the original work of the entrant. No reproductions of another artist's work are allowed.
- Each entrant may only enter one piece of artwork.
- FRAMING REQUIREMENTS: Loose pieces of paper with no backing will NOT be accepted due to hanging requirements. All work must be framed, on canvas, OR mounted on foam core or poster board. The maximum matted or framed size is 24" x 36." Artwork must weigh less than 15 lbs.
- The Bedford Public Library reserves the right to refuse any artwork deemed inappropriate for public display.
- **NEW RULE**: If teachers would like to collect and submit artwork on behalf of their students, we are capping those submissions at 20 per teacher.
- Entries must be accompanied by a completed Entry Form signed by the artist and by the artist's parent/legal guardian. The Entry Form will serve as a liability waiver and as a release allowing the Library to use and/or display the artist's work in the Library, on the Library website, and on Library-related social media.
- The artwork will be displayed in the Library and virtually from December 8, 2025, to January 4, 2026.
- Artwork will be judged by the general public during the display period. Prizes will be awarded based on a tally of the public votes. The winners will be announced by January 6, 2026.
- All artwork must be picked up at the Library by January 31, 2026 or will be forfeited.
