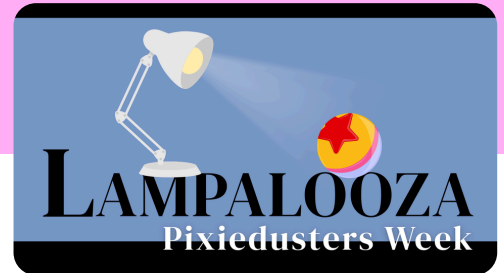

 *One registration per family.



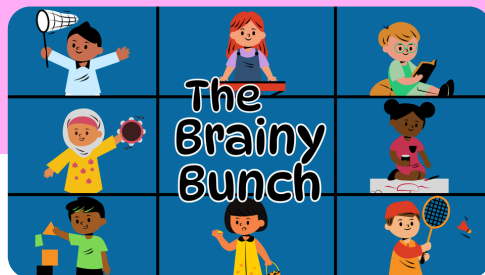
Tuesday, Apr. 7, May 5
