WHAT IS TEEN ACTION COUNCIL(TAC)?

TAC Members promote BPL teen events, plan and execute programs, brainstorm potential changes to welcome more teens and better serve the community, create social media content with Library staff, provide invaluable feedback, and strive to make the Bedford Public Library a better place for teens!

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

TAC members must be between the ages of 13 and 18 and have completed 7th grade. TAC members must attend at least 3 teen programs throughout the year and are expected to attend the monthly Wednesday meeting from 6 to 7 p.m. TAC members are expected to respond to email questions and share their opinions by participating in discussions. TAC members are required to respect the opinions, tastes, and choices of others.

HOW DO I APPLY?

If an applicant has never served on TAC before, they must fill out the application and the questionnaire. Returning TAC members are not required to fill out the questionnaire but must fill out the general application. Turn in your application and questionnaire to the Children's Information Desk or email them to abigail.yardley@bedfordtx.gov by August 23.
