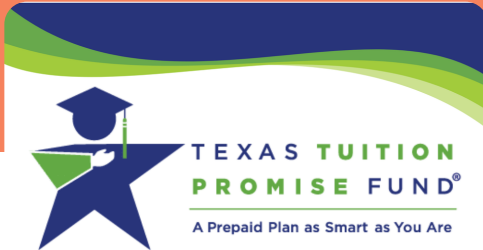

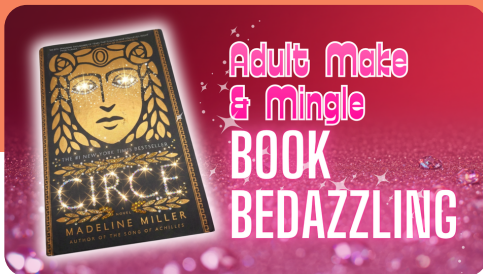
Thursday, September 3

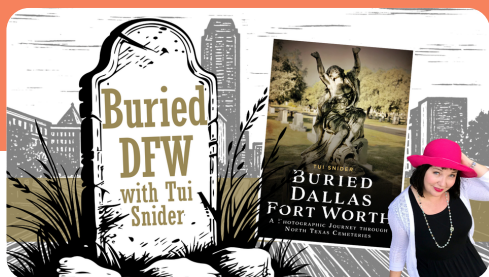

In this demo, learn how to recognize spam and safely remove it from your inbox so you won't receive more or accidentally give out personal information! First come, first served.



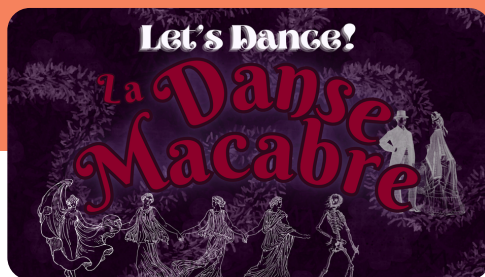
Monday, Sept. 28 | 6 to 7:30 p.m.
