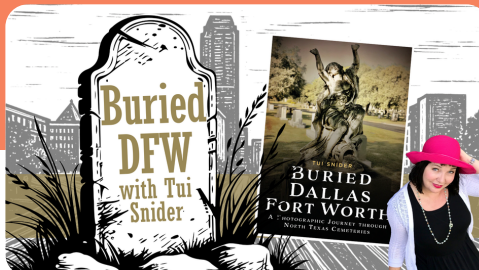
Monday, Sept. 28 | 6 to 7:30 p.m.

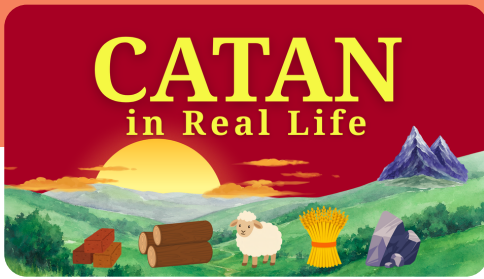
**Wednesday, October 7

Learn about the top scams reported to the Federal Trade Commission, how to avoid them, and how to report them to the FTC. First come, first served. Space is limited.



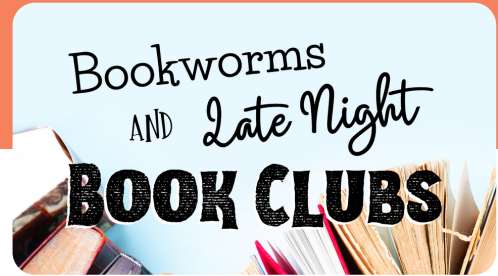
